Dear Hospice Neighbour

We're getting in touch with you to provide an update on the progress of the Mary Potter Apartments.

The renovation of the three houses on Mein Street is almost complete and ready to be rented out. We are pleased with the standard of accommodation that we will now be able to provide. They will be managed by Leaders, and rented out on the open rental market, with the income being returned to Mary Potter Hospice to help fund our services.

While the houses were being renovated we have been finalising the design and build project for the larger apartment complex. This is to be built on the empty section on the hospice site, near the Owen Street entrance.

During the Resource Consent Hearing, the Independent Commissioner imposed strict conditions on the building process. Please find enclosed with this letter a document outlining hours of operation, noise and traffic management issues, earthworks management, and the complaints process if you have any concerns.
