- Assist patients with walkers, wheelchairs etc. when transferring to and from the vehicle, their home and the Hospice
- Inform staff of any observations or concerns noted during the journey to and from the Hospice

- Carry out all activities within the guidelines set out by Mary Potter Hospice's Health & Safety policies and procedures
- Report all identified hazards, incidents (including near-misses) and accidents and carry out investigations with staff as required
- Identify, minimise and report risks

- Be able to ensure the safety and wellbeing of patients at all times
- Have good health and physical strength to carry out the physical demands of the role
